

**CEMRIAC AUTUMN MOVIE FESTIVAL
Inter-Club Competition 2020 - Entry Form**

Competition Rules:

1. Each IAC-affiliated club or society within the CEMRIAC Region may enter any number of films, subject to a maximum overall running time of 30 minutes. The maximum permitted running time for any individual film is 30 minutes.
2. Entries must not have been shown at any previous CEMRIAC competition or festival.
3. Entries must not have been produced for profit or commercial gain.
4. Entrants are responsible for obtaining permission or clearance to use any copyrighted material within their film(s).
5. Entries are acceptable in DVD, Blu-ray, and in file-based format on flash (USB drives, SD cards, etc.) or optical media in the following formats: MKV, MPEG 1/2/4, XVID, WMV9, H264, and VOB up to 1920 x 1080p. In the event of playback issues, an entrant may be asked to resubmit their entry in an alternative format. Other formats may be accepted with the Competition Officer's agreement.
6. Entries may be submitted via web download. The entrant will be asked for a URL upon receipt of their entry form(s).
7. If it becomes necessary to limit the number of entries shown at the festival the priority stated on the entry form (for multiple entrants) will determine which entries are included in the competition. Sometimes entries may be excluded after pre-judging. Entry fees for excluded movies will be refunded, and they will be eligible for entry in future CEMRIAC competitions.
8. The Interclub Trophy may only be awarded to a club with a representative present at the festival.
9. Entry implies agreement with these rules.

2. Entrants may submit up to three videos.
3. Entries must not have been shown at any previous CEMRIAC competition or festival.
4. Any length up to a maximum of 60 seconds is permitted, inclusive of titles, preambles and sound.
5. Entries must not have been made for profit or commercial gain.
6. Entrants are responsible for obtaining permission or clearance to use any copyrighted material within their film(s).
7. Entries are acceptable in DVD, Blu-ray, and in file-based format on flash (USB drives, SD cards, etc.) or optical media in the following formats: MKV, MPEG 1/2/4, XVID, WMV9, H264, and VOB up to 1920 x 1080p. In the event of playback issues, an entrant may be asked to resubmit their entry in an alternative format. Other formats may be accepted with the Competition Officer's agreement.
8. Entries may be submitted via a web download link. The entrant will be asked for a URL upon receipt of their entry form(s).
9. Discs and media should be collected at the end of the festival. Entries will not be returned unless a SAE is provided upon submission.
10. Winner's trophies should be collected at the festival by or on behalf of the entrant. Postage of trophies is at the discretion of the Competition Officer and subject to P & P.
11. Entry implies agreement with these rules.
