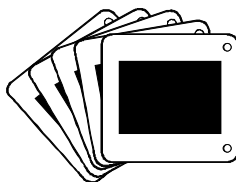

Competition Rules.

1. The competition is open to anyone in the Central and East Midlands Region of the IAC. Check with the Competition Organiser if there is any doubt about eligibility.
2. An entry form with the appropriate fee must accompany each entry together with the return postage (if required). Individual entrants must quote their IAC membership number on the entry form to qualify for the IAC members' reduced entry fee.
3. The competition is open to digital sequences only and entries must be submitted in the form of self-executable (exe) files in PC format.
4. There are no restrictions on the subject matter of any sequence.
5. The duration of any sequence must not exceed 12 minutes.
6. Entrants are responsible for copyright clearance of all material used in the sequences entered. The organisers will accept no responsibility in the case of dispute or litigation. Evidence of clearance may be required.
7. Each sequence must be the original work of the entrant and his/her declared co-authors and collaborators.
8. CEMRIAC reserve the right to refuse or withdraw any entry without giving a reason.
9. All trophies awarded at the Competition remain the property of CEMRIAC and must be returned to the Competition organiser at least six weeks before the next competition. Winners undertake to keep trophies in good condition and in a place of safety whilst in their possession.
10. In the event of any dispute, the Competition organiser's decision is final.
11. **The closing date for entries is Saturday, 21st September 2019.**
